METHODOLOGY OF CRITERIA MATERIAL SELECTION OF STATOR MAGNETIC CIRCUIT

Based on analysis of geometrical parameters of magnetic circuit of electromechanical energy converters (EMEC), the article presents a methodology of multicriteria material selection for magnetic circuit. A crucial criterion of the developed methodology is mass and dimensions parameters and its efficiency coefficient, as well as cost of magnetic circuit and minimal stamping trim. In consequence of analysis of criteria data a multicriteria goal function was obtained, which at determining weight of each criterion included in it, characterizes usage efficiency of one or another material.

STABILITY OF RARE-EARTH SmCo MAGNETS FOR LONG-TERM STORAGE.....29
A problem of stability of rare-earth magnet for long-term storage is considered. Parameters of accelerated corrosion tests simulating storage conditions of rare-earth permanent magnets during 9 years in heated warehouse premise and 3 years in field conditions are determined. The experiments determined energy activating chemical process responsible for corrosion of intermetallic compounds SmCo₅ and Sm₂Co₁₇. The obtained results were compared with the stability of magnets at their storage in natural conditions of warm humid climate of semitropics.
